We have some pictures on the following pages from this summer and the school year so far. Thanks for praying for us.

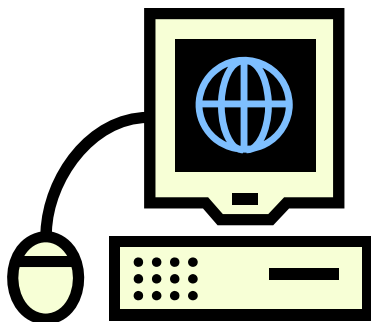

## Prayer Requests

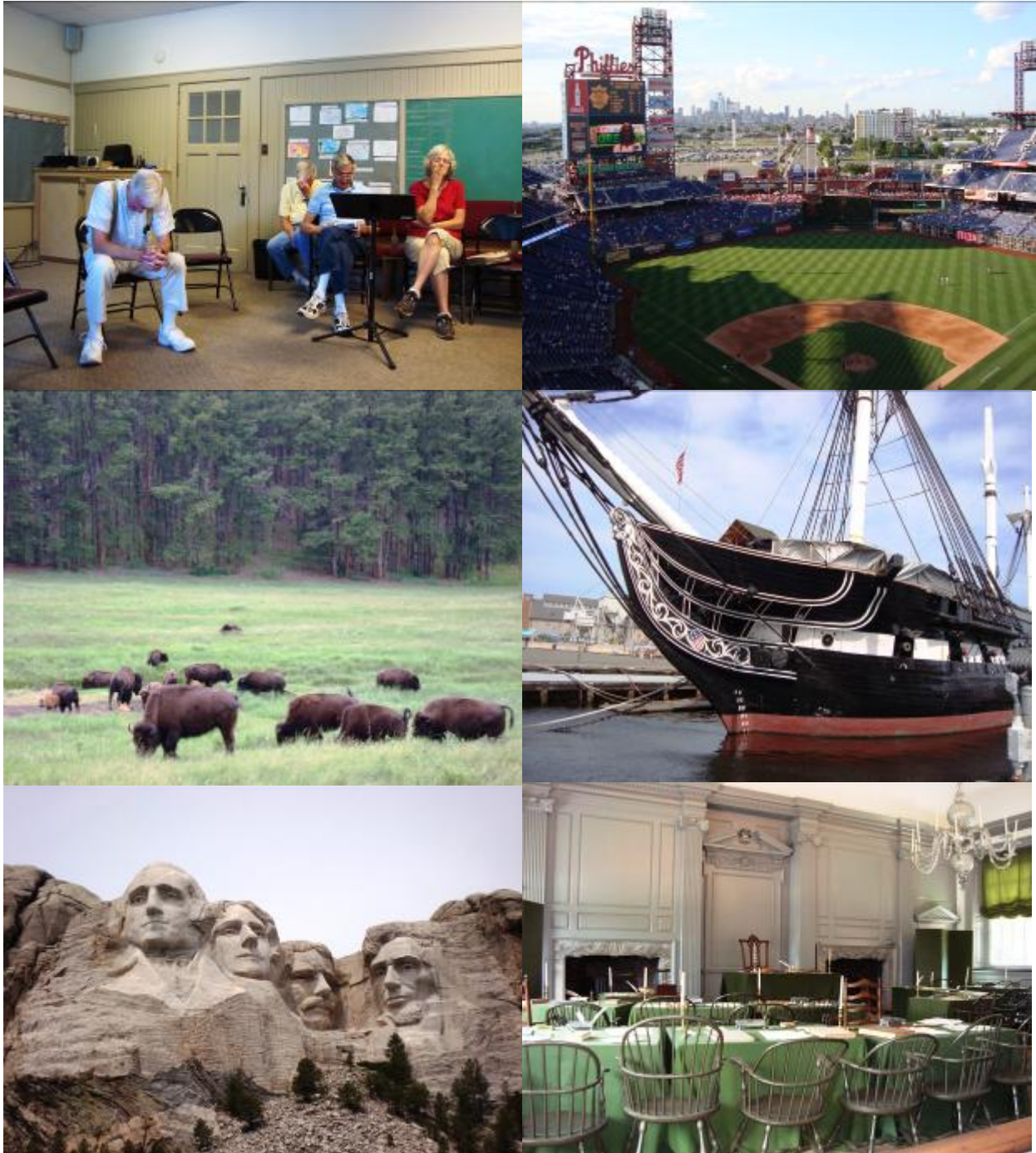
- That the staff of CCS would continue to be examples of God's grace and love
